

DURING THE LAST FEW MONTHS SENATOR YUZAK OF THE CANADIAN SENATE HAS BEEN VERY BUSY WORRYING ABOUT THE INDEPENDENCE STRUGGLE IN THE UKRAINE IN RUSSIA. HE SEEKS TO BE WORRIED ABOUT HIS PEOPLE, AND RIGHTLY SO. BUT, WE ARE WORRIED ABOUT OUR PEOPLE HERE IN CANADA WHERE HE MAKES HIS HOME. WE FEEL HE SHOULD BE HELPING ON HIS ADOPTED HOME DOORSTEP FIRST AS HE CAN DO LITTLE OR NOTHING ABOUT THE SITUATION IN RUSSIA.

HE HAS BEEN SENDING US MUCH INFORMATION ON THE UKRAINIAN PEOPLES PROBLEM IN RUSSIA. THIS IS OUR REPLY TO THE SENATE WHO SEEM TO WORRY MORE ABOUT OTHER PEOPLES PROBLEMS AND NOT CANADIAN PROBLEMS. WE SUGGEST OTHER INTERESTED PERSONS OR NATIVE ORGANIZATIONS TAKE A STAND WITH THIS AND MAKE THEIR FEELINGS PUBLIC.

HONOURABLE MEMBERS OF THE CANADIAN SENATE

WE HAVE RECEIVED A COPY OF SENATE DEBATES JUNE 3, 1971 AND HAVING READ THE DEBATE ON FOREIGN AFFAIRS WOULD LIKE TO DRAW YOUR ATTENTION TO THESE FEW COMMENTS FROM YOUR OWN DOORSTEP.

FIRST OF ALL WE WOULD LIKE TO BRING YOUR ATTENTION TO THE CANADIAN BILL OF RIGHTS - PART I, PL. WHEREIN IT STATES: IT IS HEREBY RECOGNIZED AND DECLARED THAT IN CANADA THERE HAVE EXISTED AND SHALL CONTINUE TO EXIST WITHOUT DISCRIMINATION BY REASON OF RACE, NATIONAL ORIGIN, COLOUR, RELIGION, OR SEX, THE FOLLOWING HUMAN RIGHTS AND FUNDAMENTAL FREEDOMS, NAMELY:

- A) THE RIGHT OF THE INDIVIDUAL TO LIFE, LIBERTY, SECURITY OF THE PERSON AND ENJOYMENT OF PROPERTY, AND THE RIGHT NOT TO BE DEPRIVED THEREOF EXCEPT BY DUE PROCESS OF LAW;
- B) THE RIGHT OF THE INDIVIDUAL TO EQUALITY BEFORE THE LAW AND THE PROTECTION OF THE LAW;
- C) FREEDOM OF RELIGION;
- D) FREEDOM OF SPEECH;
- E) FREEDOM OF ASSEMBLY AND ASSOCIATION; AND
- F) FREEDOM OF THE PRESS.

SECONDLY WE WOULD LIKE TO BRING YOUR ATTENTION TO THE SIMILARITIES BETWEEN THE NATIVE PEOPLES PROBLEMS IN CANADA AND THE PROBLEMS OF THE PEOPLE OF THE UKRAINE.

- A) WE ARE A SEPARATE RACE OF PEOPLE LIVING IN A COUNTRY WHICH DOES NOT TREAT US FAIRLY OR JUSTLY.
- B) WE TOO WANT THE RIGHT TO DETERMINE OUR OWN DESTINY.
- C) WE HAVE ALSO BEEN INVOLVED IN MAKING TREATIES THE MAJORITY OF WHICH HAVE BEEN DISHONORED:

NORTH WEST ANGLE TREATY NO. 2

OU APPELLE TREATY NO. 5

THESE THREE THINGS HAVE A BASIC SIMILARITY WITH THE TREATMENT OF THE UKRAINE BY RUSSIA. THE HONOURABLE MR. YUZAK SEEKS TO SUPPORT ON INTELLECTUAL INDEPENDENCE MOVEMENT BY THE NATIVE PEOPLE OF CANADA.

WE HAVE TO DIFFER HERE FROM THE UKRAINIAN MOVEMENT AS WE LACK INTELLECTUALS. THE CAUSES OF THIS PHENOMENON IS FORCED ASSIMILATION AND ASSIMILATION POLICIES. THE HONOURABLE MR. YUZAK SPEAKS OF THE DECREE OF RUSSIA AND THE SUBVERSION OF THE FREE WORLD.

FIRST OF ALL AGAIN READ TREATIES OF CANADA - IS THIS NOT DECEIT AND TRICKERY. THE TREATIES WITH THE INDIAN AND METIS HAVE BEEN BROKEN TIME AND TIME AGAIN.

DO YOU SUPPORT THE UKRAINE AGAINST COLONIAL OPPRESSION AND NOT US THE NATIVE OF CANADA.

YOU SPEAK OF THE SUBVERSION OF THE FREE WORLD. FOUR HUNDRED YEARS AGO YOUR PEOPLE STARTED SUBVERTING OUR LEADERS AND IT HAS BEEN GOING ON EVER SINCE.

FREE WORLD DEPENDS ON HOW FAR UP OR DOWN YOU DWELL ON THE TOTAL POLE OF SOCIETY. IT SEEMS THAT IN NEITHER COUNTRY DOES THE BASIC RIGHT OF DETERMINING ONE'S DESTINY EITHER AS INDIVIDUALS OR GROUPS EXIST.

EVERY NATION IS ENTITLED TO ESTABLISH AN INDEPENDENT NATIONAL STATE OF ITS OWN. THIS IS A BASIC HUMAN RIGHT. IT HAS TO BE HONORED NOT ONLY IN THE U.S.S.R., BUT HERE IN THE COUNTRY YOU ARE CLAIMING AS YOURS. TO SUM UP LET ME SAY THAT YOU CANNOT SUPPORT ONE COUNTRY'S INDEPENDENCE STRUGGLE WITHOUT SUPPORTING ALL SUCH STRUGGLES. THIS ALSO AFFECTS DIFFERENT RACES OF PEOPLE UNDER COLONIAL RULE AS WE ARE, A NOTE FOR YOUR ATTENTION MR. YUZAK, YOU STATE -- THE UKRAINIAN, THE POLES, THE ITALIANS, THE SERBS, AND OTHERS -- THESE TOGETHER WITH THE TWO FOUNDING RACES, MAKE UP THE CANADIAN FAMILY.

FOUNDING RACES? MR. YUZAK, THE NATIVE PEOPLE OF THIS COUNTRY FOUNDED THIS COUNTRY. THE FRENCH AND BRITISH CONQUERED US BOTH PHYSICALLY AND MORALLY. YOUR JUSTIFICATION OF THE UKRAINIAN STRUGGLE, HAS JUSTIFIED OUR STRUGGLE. YOU ARE THE INTRUDER, WE ARE THE FOUNDING RACE. THE METIS NATION IS PERVERSE, HE WOULD LIKE THIS READ TO THE HONORABLE MR. YUZAK AND OTHER MEMBERS OF THE CANADIAN SENATE BY THE SPEAKER OF THE SENATE.

Editorial

AS THIS ISSUE OF THE "NEW BREED" GOES TO PRESS, MANY OF US ARE GETTING READY TO GO TO OTTAWA, AT THIS TIME MANY BRIEFS WILL BE PRESENTED FROM VARIOUS NATIVE GROUPS THROUGHOUT THE PROVINCE. SOME BRIEFS ARE FROM OUR PEOPLE SERVING TIME IN THE PRISONS OF SASKATCHEWAN, OTHERS ARE ON SUBJECTS FROM FARMING TO NATIVE RIGHTS. ALL THESE BRIEFS AND PROPOSALS MEAN MAINLY ONE THING AND THAT IS THAT NATIVE PEOPLE ARE THROUGH SITTING BACK AND TAKING HANDOUTS WITH STRINGS ATTACHED. THEY ARE NO LONGER SATISFIED TO BE SECOND CLASS CITIZENS IN THEIR OWN COUNTRY. THEY ARE NOW SPEAKING OUT AND THE VOICE IS BECOMING LOUDER AND LOUDER.

THE THINGS THEY ARE ASKING FOR ARE NOT SELFISH NOR ARE THEY MORE OF THE OLD HANDOUT DEMANDS. ALL THE REQUESTS HAVE A BASIC THEME AND THAT IS TO HELP OR AID OUR OWN PEOPLES TO STAND UP PROUD AND CAST OFF THE CHAIN OF COLONIZATION. IF THESE REQUESTS AND PROPOSALS ARE IMPLEMENTED THEN THE BURDEN LOAD OF THOSE INVOLVED WILL BE ENORMOUS. MOST OF THE PEOPLE INVOLVED IN THIS TRIP ARE PEOPLE WHO HAVE LOOKED AROUND, SAW A JOB TO BE DONE, AND PROCEEDED TO DO IT.

ONE OF THESE BRIEFS IS IN THE AREA OF COMMUNICATION, ESPECIALLY IN THE NORTHERN REGIONS WHERE COMMUNICATIONS ARE FOR THE MOST PART CONTROLLED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES AND PRIVATE COMPANIES. ALL OVER SASKATCHEWAN WE HAVE A DESPERATE LACK OF NATIVE NEWSPAPERS, TELEVISION AND RADIO PROGRAMMING. AND IT IS NO USE HAVING A PIECE OF SOMEONE ELSE'S PROGRAM OR PAPER BECAUSE WE WANT TO SAY THINGS IN THE WAY WE WANT TO SAY THEM. WHAT IS VERY IMPORTANT TO US AS NATIVES MIGHT NOT BE IMPORTANT TO THE WHITE SOCIETY, AND THEY CONTROL EVERYTHING.

SOME FROM THE PRISONS ARE SHOWING PEOPLE AND THE GOVERNMENT HOW WRONG IT IS TO PICK SOMEONE OUT OF SOCIETY'S END RESULT, LOCK HIM OR HER UP FOR MONTHS OR YEARS, THEN DUMP HIM OUT INTO THE SAME OLD MESS. AGAIN WE HAVE HERE THE IDEA OF THOSE WHO HAVE A PROBLEM SOLVING IT FOR THEMSELVES, AND PEOPLE HELPING PEOPLE. AT THE LAST COUNT ALMOST 80% OF MEN SERVING TIME WERE OF NATIVE ORIGIN AND THE OFFENSES WERE MOSTLY CAUSED BY LIQUOR. IN THE WOMEN'S CASE, NATIVE WOMEN MAKE UP ALMOST 90% OF THE TOTAL WOMEN SERVING TIME. THESE PEOPLE HAVE THE ANSWERS TO THEIR OWN PROBLEMS LET THEM TRY AND SOLVE THEM THEMSELVES.

Editorial

HOUSING, EDUCATION, AND JOBS ARE THE THREE MOST IMPORTANT THINGS OUR PEOPLE ARE ASKING FOR RIGHT NOW. THESE ARE BASIC HUMAN RIGHTS AND SHOULD BE HONOURED IN TOTAL. CANADA IS THE SECOND RICHEST COUNTRY IN THE WORLD AND YET SHE IS FAILING TO SOLVE THESE THREE BASIC PROBLEMS. MAKES YOU WONDER - DOESN'T IT?

AT A MEETING AT THE REGINA NATIVE YOUTH PROGRAM CENTRE OUR PRESIDENT, MR. JIM SINCLAIR, STATED THAT HE HAVE TO FIGHT FOR OUR RIGHTS. MR. Saylor, OF THE REGINA CITY POLICE, SAID THAT FIGHTING IS NO GOOD - HE HAVE TO WORK, O.K. WELL I AGREE WITH JIM. WE HAVE TO FIGHT FOR OUR RIGHTS AND DIGNITY AND THIS IS WORK, HARD WORK AND FRUSTRATING WORK. IN ANSWER TO MR. Saylor, FIGHTING IS NOT NECESSARILY PHYSICAL, YOU CAN FIGHT WITH WORDS AND MANY OTHER WAYS. THE WORK YOU MEANT IS THE AGE OLD EXPRESSION OF TELLING INDIANS TO GO TO WORK WHEN THERE IS NO WORK AND THAT GOES FOR THE WHITES, TOO. YOU PROBABLY FEEL THAT ANYONE WHO HAS NO WORK IS PROBABLY LAZY. TAKE OFF YOUR SHADES AND LOOK AROUND YOU - UNEMPLOYMENT IS AS HIGH NOW AS IT WAS BEFORE THE WAR.

They're Demanding Total Employment . . .

COMMUNAL OR CO-OPERATIVE DEVELOPMENT

METIS COMMUNITIES

MOST METIS COMMUNITIES HAVE BEEN NEGLECTED ECONOMICALLY OVER THE PAST YEARS. HENCE, THERE ARE NO INDUSTRIES, FACTORIES OR ANY KIND OF PREDPABLE ECONOMY. EVER SINCE THE GOVERNMENT DESTROYED THE BUFFALO ECONOMY ONE HUNDRED YEARS AGO, IT HAS DELIBERATELY KEPT OUR COMMUNITIES ECONOMICALLY POOR AND UNDEVELOPED. WE HAVE NEVER BEEN COMPENSATED FOR THIS TOTAL DESTRUCTION OF OUR ECONOMY. INSTEAD WE HAVE BEEN FORCED TO LIVE IN POVERTY, OFTEN ON WELFARE, AND WITHOUT ANY POLITICAL POWER. ROM HE MUST REBUILD OUR COMMUNITIES ECONOMICALLY.

SINCE THE GOVERNMENTS ONE US MILLIONS OF DOLLARS IN COMPENSATION, WE MUST DEMAND THIS MONEY, AND USE IT TO DEVELOP OUR COMMUNITIES. SO THEY WILL PROVIDE A MEANS OF LIVING FOR ALL OF US. THE OTTAWA GOVERNMENT DOES NOT HESITATE TO GIVE EIGHTY MILLION DOLLARS TO WHITE BUSINESSMEN WITHOUT THEM EVEN ASKING FOR IT.

THE METIS OF SASKATCHEWAN SHOULD DEMAND AN EQUIVALENT AMOUNT. IT IS CERTAIN THAT SUCH MONEY WOULD PROVIDE JOBS AND LIVELIHOOD FOR MOST OF THE SIXTY THOUSAND HALFBREEDS OF SASKATCHEWAN. HOWEVER, THE DEVELOPMENT OF OUR COMMUNITIES MUST BE DONE ON A COMMUNAL, CO-OPERATIVE, SOCIALIST BASIS. IT IS NECESSARY TO THINK IN TERMS OF THE WHOLE COMMUNAL NATION OF THE METIS OF SASKATCHEWAN, AND NOT IN TERMS OF JUST A FEW PRIVILEGED HALFBREEDS. WE MUST CONCERN OURSELVES ABOUT THE MASSES OF OUR PEOPLE; OF ALL OF OUR BROTHERS AND SISTERS, AND ABOUT THE NATION.

EVERY COMMUNITY SHOULD DEVELOP ITS OWN INDUSTRY, SUCH AS A BOX FACTORY, PLYWOOD PLANT, SAW MILL, OR TANNERY, OR WHATEVER IS BEST FOR THE COMMUNITY IN TERMS OF RESOURCES AVAILABLE. THESE FACTORIES SHOULD BE DEVELOPED FOR THE BENEFIT OF ALL NATIVE PEOPLE OF THAT PARTICULAR AREA. THEY WOULD BE UNDER EXCLUSIVE CONTROL AND MANAGEMENT OF LOCAL NATIVE PEOPLE, AS A GROUP. THERE WOULD BE PAID MASSES THAT WOULD PROVIDE A DECENT LIVING. FINISHED PRODUCTS FROM THE FACTORIES WOULD BE SOLD PRIMARILY TO NATIVE PEOPLE OF THE LOCAL AND PROVINCIAL AREAS. THESE FACTORIES WOULD BECOME SELF SUPPORTING AS SOON AS POSSIBLE, FROM THE PROFITS OF THEIR SALES.

IN THE SOUTH THERE MAY BE GREATER DEVELOPMENT IN FARMING INDUSTRIES. FOR THIS KIND OF COMMUNAL CO-OPERATIVE SOCIETY WE WOULD NEED SKILLED WORKERS, TECHNICIANS AND BUSINESS ADMINISTRATORS, AS WELL AS A SPECIAL KIND OF POLITICAL KNOWLEDGE.

TOGETHER WITH THIS METIS FACTORY SYSTEM, A SUPPORTING SCHEME OF LOCAL FARMS, SUCH AS GRAIN FARMING, RANCHING, GARDENING AND OTHER FARMS WILL NEED TO BE ESTABLISHED IN ORDER TO PROVIDE FOOD FOR THE WHOLE NATIVE COMMUNITY. ALTHOUGH THESE FARMS COULD BE OPERATED ON AN INDIVIDUAL BASIS, THEY WOULD SERVE AS PART OF THE TOTAL HALFBREED COMMUNITY OR NATION. THIS TYPE OF A CO-OPERATIVE SOCIALIST SYSTEM WILL NOT NECESSARILY MAKE METIS WORKERS AND FARMERS RICH, BUT IT WILL PROVIDE GOOD WAGES; A DECENT, SECURE AND DIGNIFIED LIVING FOR THE GREAT MAJORITY OF OUR PEOPLE. IN ADDITION THIS SCHEME WOULD PROVIDE FOR THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT OF ALL METIS COMMUNITIES, BOTH NORTH AND SOUTH.

THE DETAILS OF SUCH FACTORIES AND FARM INDUSTRIES CAN BE WORKED OUT AFTER WE HAVE AGREED ON A COMMUNAL SOCIALIST SYSTEM FOR OUR NATIVE COMMUNITIES AND NATION. HOWEVER, THIS PROGRAM MEANS A LOT OF PLANNING AND PREPARATION, WHICH MUST BE DONE NOW. WE MUST UNITE, WORK TOGETHER AND FRIENDS CAN CARRY ON. FOR THE PROVINCIAL AND FEDERAL GOVERNMENTS, FOR THE NECESSARY GRANTS OF MONEY - COMPENSATION FOR OUR DESTROYED ECONOMY. AT THE SAME TIME OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, WE MUST TAKE OVER OTHER ACTIVITIES IN OUR COMMUNITIES, SUCH AS SCHOOLS, RECREATIONAL AND CULTURAL PROGRAMS. THE SCHOOLS SHOULD BE PART OF THE METIS COMMUNAL SYSTEM; TIED CLOSELY TO THE FACTORIES AND FARMS. THEY SHOULD BE CHANGED COMPLETELY TO MEET OUR NEEDS AND OUR CULTURE, AND MADE MORE REALISTIC AND PRACTICAL. RACISM AND INFERIORIZATION IN THE EDUCATIONAL SYSTEM MUST BE STOPPED AND THE SOONER, THE BETTER.

DISCUSS THIS PLAN WITH YOUR BROTHERS AND SISTERS. THEN SEND US YOUR IDEAS AND PROPOSALS ON THIS SUGGESTION AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.

TOURIST INDUSTRY

Tourist business in our native land of Northern Saskatchewan is not the answer to our economic problems. Regardless of how carefully it is planned, tourism never really benefits the local people, except for a few. tourist business for the white people is actually harmful to the metis and Indians. And their land, laws and rules are made that eventually destroy and kill the animals we need so badly for our daily food. Hunters or sportsmen are allowed to kill for pleasure, and not for need, while we are prevented from hunting or fishing for much needed food. Tourism in the north attracts mostly the white American and Canadian businessmen, who usually have white supremacy attitudes towards our people, and

consequently treat us as inferiors. These men exploit not only the game and fish in our area, but also the young native girls. tourist industry does not bring development or health to our communities. All tourists bring most of their money on equipment, transportation and liquor before they arrive in the north. the kind of jobs given to our people are guiding, cleaning, and the usual dirty jobs. the rate of pay to us is often poor, so that we have to depend on tips, which forces us to cater to white people. in this way we become little more than beggars or servants. This creates a very bad impression for the rest of our people, especially the young people who are struggling for equality and freedom.

Tourist industry means giving up more of our land and resources for the pleasures of whitemen. instead the metis should develop the land and forests for themselves. tourism does not allow the native people to be in positions of control of our land. it is the usual type of industry that is established in colonial and underdeveloped countries, and which exploits the native people. as halfbreeds of saskatchewan, we are now capable of managing and developing our country. it is time we became masters of our land and decided for ourselves the kind of industries we want established.



Discrimination claimed against Indian students

NORTH BATTLEFORD — A North Battleford provincial government teacher has filed allegations of discrimination against Indian students he has been called for by the Red Pineapple Indian band.

Gerald Williams, a 40-year-old teacher at the Red Pineapple school, who is posted to the segregated school in Canada, has complained to the provincial attorney-general's department and police justice department in Ottawa.

He said the band has started an investigation of its own and that an Indian affairs representative recently took part in the inquiry.

However, Mr. Williams said the band was not satisfied with the report and has asked the province to investigate between the Indian Affairs officer only in the battlefords.

"That's like asking the cat that swallowed the prime minister to go back and spit him out again," he said.

Mr. Williams said there has been a problem at the school since the students first began attending about three years ago.

To solve the integration problem, Mr. Williams said the Indian Affairs representative must move into the building of a new school.

"But they don't integrate the children. All they integrate was the money."

NORTHERN CO-OP TRADING SERVICES LTD. WITH ITS HEAD OFFICE IN PRINCE ALBERT AND A CHAIN OF "CO-OPERATIVE" STORES ON THE NORTH EASTERN SIDE OF SASKATCHEWAN HAS PUT IN A BID FOR THE WEST SIDE INDEPENDENT CO-OP STORES AND AFTER A BRIEF STRUGGLE HAS WON.

LOCAL BOARDS OF DIRECTORS OF THE INDEPENDANT CO-OPS STRUCK OUT DEFIANTLY AT FIRST TO MAINTAIN THEIR CONTROL AND INDEPENDENCE FROM THE AUTHORITARIAN CHAIN, BUT UNDER INCREASING PRESSURE FROM THE PERSONNEL HIRED BY THE PROVINCIAL DEPARTMENT OF CO-OPERATION, THEY HAVE HAD TO CONCEDE TO A "SUPERIOR" CO-OP CHAIN AND RECEDE INTO OBELIVION AS DIRECTORS.

THE METHOD UTILIZED BY MR. TORNQUISH AND MR. FISHER OF THE DEPARTMENT CO-OPERATION HAVE BEEN MOST SUCCESSFUL IN THEIR PLAY TO REDUCE THESE CO-OPERATIONS TO SUCCESS TO THEIR PLAN OF TAKE-OVER.

LOOKING BACK AT THEIR TACTICS NOW, FIRST THEY SUGGESTED AN AMALGAMATION WITH N.C.T.S. WHEN THAT SUGGESTION WAS REFUSED BY THE INDEPENDANT CO-OPS, THEY THEN REFUSED FURTHER ACCOUNTING SERVICES TO THESE STORES UNTIL THEY WERE PAID A FEE FOR THESE VITAL SERVICES. FOR YEARS PREVIOUS TO THIS, THE DEPARTMENT OF CO-OPS HAVE PROVIDED FEEDLEMEN IN THE NORTHERN COMMUNITIES, HAVE PROVIDED MANAGEMENT, ADVISORS, AND ACCOUNTANTS, SO THE FINAL BREAK-UP WAS EVIDENT; THEY PULLED OUT ALL THEIR PERSONNEL AND DEMANDED A FEE FOR SERVICES.

IT WOULD APPEAR OBVIOUS THAT THE CONSEQUENCE HAS MANAGEMENT DIFFICULTY BECAUSE INCREASED PRESSURE WAS BROUGHT TO BEAR UPON THE MANAGERS BECAUSE OF THE UNCERTAINTY CREATED. PROBLEMS DEVELOPED AND CO-OP PERSONNEL STOOD BY AND WATCHED THE DERAILMENT WAITING FOR THE MOVEMENT TO REIZE THEM AND PRESS ON WITH THEIR PLAN OF AMALGAMATING THE INDEPENDANT STORES INTO NORTHERN CO-OP TRADING SERVICES.

WHILE THE NEW CHAIN STORES WILL PROVIDE THE RETAIL SERVICES, THEY HAVE SHATTERED THE CONCEPT OF CO-OPERATION AND PERPETUATED THE CONCEPT OF PATRICALISM TOWARDS THE NATIVE BOARD DIRECTOR AND CUSTOMER.

IT CANNOT BE DENIED THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF CO-OPERATION SET UP THE ORIGINAL STORES WITH THEIR PRE-CONCEIVED CONCEPT OF BUSINESS, AND THROUGHOUT THE YEARS PATERNALLY PROVIDED FOR ALL THE NEEDS OF THE BUSINESS. THE LOCAL BOARDS OF DIRECTORS WERE "CONSULTED" ONLY AS A ROUTINE, BUT THE PRE-CONCEIVED PLANS WERE THE ACTUAL PLANS. THUS, THE INITIATIVE THAT THE LOCAL COULD HAVE UTILIZED WAS UNNECESSARY AND ANY IDEAS WERE FRUSTRATED TO THE POINT WHERE THE DEPARTMENT OF CO-OPS HAS NOT ACTED IN A CO-OPERATIVE MANNER BECAUSE THEY FORCED THEIR IDEAS.

THE CHAIN-STORE CO-OP HAS ISOLATED THE ORIGINAL CONCEPT OF CO-OPERATION BECAUSE BY ORGANIZING THEMSELVES ON SUCH A LARGE SCALE, THE CONTROL HAS BEEN REMOVED FROM THE LOCAL LEVEL TO BE LIMITED TO TOP LEVEL MANAGEMENT AND EVERYONE KNOWS MANAGEMENT OR THAT SCALE KNOW ALL THE ANSWERS AND YOU JUST DON'T DARE TO DISAGREE!

THE ONLY TROUBLE IS, AND IS PROBLEM ENOUGH, IS THE FACT THAT THE BLAME FOR THE DECLINE OF THESE INDEPENDANT STORES RESTS SOLELY WITH LOCAL MANAGEMENT AS FAR AS THE DEPARTMENT OF CO-OP IS CONCERNED, AND THAT MANAGEMENT INCLUDES THE ENTIRE SPECTRUM OF THE COMMUNITY FROM THE CONSUMER DOWN TO THE STORE MANAGER. THE BLAME GOES TO THE CONSUMER FOR HIS "UNWISE" CREDIT BUYING, TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS FOR THEIR LACK OF INITIATIVE, AND IN THE ENDLESS TURNOIL, THE CONFUSED STORE MANAGERS AND FOR MISMANAGEMENT. CONVERSELY, THESE STORES WOULD NOT TODAY HAVE LISTED SUCH HIGH ACCOUNTS RECEIVABLES HAD THEY UTILIZED A REASONABLE SYSTEM OF WRITING OFF "DEAD" ACCOUNTS. AND THEY WOULD HAVE HAD AN INTERESTED AND ACTIVE BOARD OF DIRECTORS HAD THERE BEEN NO FRUSTRATING ENCOUNTERS WITH THE GOVERNMENT BACKERS, AND GOOD MANAGEMENT HAD THE MANAGER BEEN LEFT TO MANAGING HIS STORE INSTEAD OF BEING CAUGHT BETWEEN POLICIES.

Mid Canada Development Corridor

THERE HAS BEEN MORE AND MORE TALK LATELY ABOUT DEVELOPING THE NORTH. THIS BY ITSELF WOULD SEEM LIKE A NORMAL THING TO DO. THE NORTH HAS MANY RESOURCES AND PEOPLE NEED THESE THINGS - ETC.

WHO IS GOING TO BENEFIT FROM THESE RESOURCES. WHO WILL DECIDE WHAT RESOURCES WILL BE USED AND HOW THEY WILL BE USED, IS THIS LARGE SCALE PLAN GOING TO BENEFIT OR JUST A CHOSEN FEW, WHO OWNS THE NORTH, WHEN WE LOOK AT THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE NORTH WE HAVE TO ASK OURSELVES THESE QUESTIONS. THE GREAT MAJORITY OF THE PEOPLE IN THE NORTH ARE NATIVE. ARE THEY GOING TO BENEFIT OR IS IT THE SAME OLD EXPLOITATION OF NATIVE BY WHITE AGAIN.

Corridor - continued

LET US GO OVER THESE DEVELOPMENT IDEAS OURSELVES. LET US STATE OPENLY HOW WE FEEL ABOUT THIS. AND LET US PUT FORWARD OUR IDEAS AS NATIVES IN OUR OWN COUNTRY. WE KNOW THAT IT IS MAINLY AMERICANS WHO ARE INVOLVED IN THIS DEVELOPMENT. WE KNOW THE MAJORITY OF THE PROFITS WILL GO TO THE UNITED STATES. WE KNOW THEY NEED THE RESOURCES ESPECIALLY OUR WATER IN THE SOUTH WEST. WE KNOW THEY WANT TO MANUFACTURE OUR RESOURCES INTO THEIR FINISHED PRODUCTS THEN SELL THEM BACK TO US AT HIGH COST. WE KNOW ALSO THAT WHEN BIG INDUSTRY TALKS OF DEVELOPMENT THEY MEAN EXPLOITATION AGAIN OF NATIVE PEOPLE. WHEN THEY SPEAK ABOUT "HUMAN RESOURCES" THEY MEAN TO USE US JUST AS THEY WANT TO USE ALL OUR OTHER RESOURCES.

1. WE BELIEVE THAT ALL RESOURCES SHOULD BE LEFT AS THEY ARE -- UNLESS -- THEY ARE USED TO BENEFIT ALL PEOPLE AND NOT JUST A FEW EXPLORERS. WE BELIEVE THAT ALL RESOURCES SHOULD BE USED AND MANUFACTURED HERE BY US FOR OUR BENEFIT, THEN, THE SURPLUS CAN BE EXPORTED AT OUR COST.
2. IF WE ARE GOING TO USE RESOURCES LET'S MAKE SURE THE PEOPLE ARE IN FULL CONTROL OF THEM. IF THERE IS TO BE AN IRON MINE AT CHOICELAND, LET THERE ALSO BE A STEEL MILL AT PRINCE ALBERT SUPPLYING VARIOUS OTHER SUB INDUSTRIES THROUGHOUT THE PROVINCE, AND LET IT BE OWNED BY THE PEOPLE OF SASKATCHEWAN.
- 3) IF THERE HAS TO BE A PULP MILL AT DORE LAKE LET US USE IT SENSIBLY. ALL FACETS OF THE PAPER AND TIMBER INDUSTRY LOCATED IN SASKATCHEWAN AND THE PROJECT OWNED AND OPERATED BY THE PEOPLE. LET US HAVE THE FOREST PRIMARILY WITH THE ADVICE OF THE LOCAL PEOPLE WHO KNOW THE ENVIRONMENTAL SITUATION, AND IF IT IS TO BE BUILT LET IT BE BUILT WITH TOTAL POLLUTION CONTROL TO PREVENT POLLUTION AND NOT TRY AND CURE IT AFTER IT IS POLLUTED.
- 4) WHY CAN WE NOT PROCESS THE POTASH MINED IN SASKATCHEWAN OURSELVES. SHOULD WE KEEP ON BEING EXPLOITED BY FOREIGN OR INDIVIDUAL INTERESTS WHEN ALL COULD BENEFIT IF IT WAS PROPERLY HANDLED. THE BENEFIT OF THESE THREE AREAS OF INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT TO THE PEOPLE OF SASKATCHEWAN IS GREAT IN EMPLOYMENT POTENTIAL AND IN A GOOD STANDARD OF LIVING FOR ALL INVOLVED. THESE THREE MAJOR INDUSTRIES ARE TO BE OWNED AND OPERATED BY THE PEOPLE OF SASKATCHEWAN. ALL OTHER SUB INDUSTRIES SHOULD BE OWNED AND OPERATED BY THE LOCAL COMMUNITIES OR AREAS INVOLVED. ALL MANUFACTURING TO SUIT THE NEEDS OF THE PEOPLE FIRST WITH EXPORT OR TRADE SECONDARY.

THE FIRST NIGHT THEY WERE IN ABERNETHY, THEY SAID THEY WISH THEY WERE HOME, BUT NOW YOU ASK THEM IF THEY WOULD LIKE TO GO HOME, THEY'RE ANSWER IS "NO WAY". THEY LIKE THE PEOPLE VERY MUCH.

GLADYS AND JOYCE ARE BOARDING AT MR. & MRS. ED LAFAYETTE, AND THEY SAID NO ONE COULD BE AS LUCKY AS THEY ARE TO FIND ANYONE AS NICE AS ED AND DOROTHY, THE GIRLS ARE ENJOYING THEIR WORK AROUND ABERNETHY AND BALCARRE.

1. THE ONLY PLACE TO MAKE SUBSCRIPTIONS FOR THE "NEW BREED" IS TO THE "NEW BREED" OFFICE, DO NOT APPLY FOR SUBSCRIPTIONS BY FRIENDS OR ANYONE ELSE, ONLY DIRECTLY TO US. THIS MAY WE CAN HONOUR YOUR CLAIM IF YOU DO NOT RECEIVE YOUR ISSUE.
 2. IF YOU AS A MEMBER OF A LOCAL, FIND THAT YOUR LOCAL DOES NOT RECEIVE THE "NEW BREED", THEN LET US KNOW IMMEDIATELY, SOMETIMES THEY ARE HELD BACK BY ACCIDENT, OR SOMETIMES HELD BACK DELIBERATELY.
 3. IF YOU HAVE ANY CRITICISM OF THE PAPER OR ITS CONTENT LET US KNOW, WHY YOU DON'T LIKE IT, AND A SUGGESTION TO CHANGE IT, WE CANNOT ACT ON WORD OF MOUTH COMPLAINTS UNLESS IT IS FIRST HAND FROM THE PERSON WITH THE COMPLAINT.



NATIVE ALCOHOL COUNCIL

THE NATIVE ALCOHOL COUNCIL PROGRAM HAS BEEN CO-ORDINATED INTO THE METIS SOCIETY PROGRAM.

IT HAS THE FULL BACKING OF THE METIS SOCIETY IN ITS OPERATIONS IN ALCOHOL EDUCATION FOR THE NATIVE POPULATION IN SASKATCHEWAN.

NATIVE ALCOHOL COUNCIL WILL BE LAUNCHING A SERIES OF ALCOHOL AND DRUG SEMINARS. MAIN OBJECT OF THESE SEMINARS IS TO RELATE TO THE PEOPLE THE DAMAGE CAUSED BY THE EXCESSIVE USE OF ALCOHOL IN ANY SPECIFIED AREA OF SASKATCHEWAN.

THE HOUSE IN NORTH BATTLEFORD HAS GRADUATED TO DATE 80 PATIENTS AND THE EXTENT OF SORRIENCE (OR TOTAL ABSTINENCE) HAS BEEN EXTREMELY FAVOURABLE. THAT IS ONLY 17% OF THESE HAVE GONE BACK TO DRINKING AND THE OLD PATTERN OF LIVING.

WE ARE VERY ENTHUSED ABOUT THE NUMBER THAT ARE STAYING OFF THE BOTTLE AND SEEKING A NEW WAY OF LIVING. HOWEVER, UNDERSTANDING THE ALCOHOL CONDITION IN ANY AREAS THESE PEOPLE COME FROM, WE MUST BE EXTREMELY ACTIVE IN PROVIDING THE NECESSARY FOLLOW-UP. BY FOLLOW-UP WE HAVE AN N.A.C. WORKER WORKING IN THESE AREAS ESTABLISH AA GROUPS AND WORKING WITH ALL PEOPLE IN THE FIELD OF DEVELOPMENT AND EDUCATION TO SECURE WORK AND DEVELOP A KIND OF SOCIETY THAT WOULD MAKE THESE PEOPLE COMFORTABLE TO LIVE IN.

WE HAVE A NUMBER OF PATIENTS FROM THE COMMISSION ON ALCOHOLISM THAT WE ARE ALSO PROVIDING FOLLOW-UP.

THE MEMBERSHIP OF NATIVE PEOPLE BELONGING TO ALCOHOLIC ANONYMOUS HAS TRIPLED IN SASKATCHEWAN.

OUR FIELDWORKERS ARE GREAT DEMAND AND WE HAVE MANY REQUEST FROM THE RESERVES AND METIS COMMUNITIES TO ESTABLISH AA GROUPS.

IN THE NORTH BATTLEFORD ALCOHOL CENTRE WE HAVE EXPERIMENTED IN THE ALCOHOL COMMISSION PROGRAM AND HAVE FOUND IT A LITTLE TOO DIFFICULT FOR OUR PEOPLE TO UNDERSTAND.

THE FIRST WEEK A PATIENT IS IN THE CENTRE, HE IS GIVEN A COMPLETE PHYSICAL EXAMINATION AND IS LAUNCHED WITH THE FIRST STEPS OF THE AA PROGRAM. SECOND WEEK ON THE STAY AT THE HOUSE THEY ARE GIVEN AND APPROPRIATE CERTAIN JOBS IN THE KITCHEN, HOUSE AND YARD, TO ASSIST IN MAINTENANCE OF THE BUILDING. SECOND WEEK CASES ARE STUDIED INDIVIDUALLY AND ARE INTERVIEWED BY THE DOCTOR AND DIRECTOR. THE OBJECT IN VIEW IS TO GET DOWN TO THE ROOT OF THEIR PERSONAL PROBLEMS, THESE ARE FILED AWAY AND KEPT ON RECORD AND THEY ARE LAUNCHED ON NEXT GROUP OF STEPS. THE LAST WEEK THERE THEY WORK ON LAST GROUP OF STEPS.

ANOTHER INTERVIEW IS GIVEN TO THEM BY THE DOCTOR AND DIRECTOR TO DETERMINE WHETHER THEY WANT TO WORK OR GO BACK TO THEIR RESERVE. WHEN WE HAVE FOUND OUT THE LOCATION THEY WISH TO GO WE IMMEDIATELY CONTACT THE FIELDWORKER OF THE METIS SOCIETY AND FSI WITH THE SPECIFIC PURPOSE OF LOCATING AN AA MEMBER IN THAT AREA TO PROVIDE A CONTACT AND A WORKING RELATIONSHIP WITH OUR PATIENT.

TO DATE THIS HAS BEEN WORKING VERY WELL IN THE CENTRAL AND SOUTHERN AREAS OF THE PROVINCE. WE ARE UNABLE TO DO MUCH FOR THE PATIENT THAT COMES FROM THE FAR NORTH FOR TREATMENT IN OUR CENTRE. OUR CENTRE HAS BEEN MORE THAN FILLED SINCE IT HAS BEEN OPERATING.

WE ARE IN GREAT NEED OF A LARGER CENTRE AND SMALL COUNSELLING OFFICES IN THE DIFFERENT AREAS FOR OUR FIELD STAFF TO OPERATE. THIS PROBLEM HAS BEEN PARTIALLY SOLVED BY THE METIS SOCIETY GIVING US THE USE OF THEIR LOCAL OFFICES.

CHIEF EDD BIRD PASSES AWAY

CHIEF EDD BIRD of Fort Smith died early in the morning of August 27 at University Hospital in Edmonton. He died three weeks after receiving gunshot wounds in an incident which he later claimed was self-defense. He was 46 years old.

After being wounded Chief Bird's condition seemed to be getting better in Edmonton Telferwood Hospital but two weeks ago he became ill again and was admitted for better medical care. The doctors did operations but there was too much internal damage from the chest wounds to save him.

Chief Bird was elected Chief of the PICE-BEUD band of Chipewyan people in the area of Fort Smith in the Northwest Territories and Fitzgerald in Alberta in July 1970.



For the past year he has been working for the Royal Canadian Mounted Police as a member of the Indian Affairs Branch, Department of the Northwest Territories. He was elected Secretary Treasurer of the Brotherhood in March of this year. He and his wife, Mrs. Jeanne Bird, have a 2 year old daughter, Roxanna; a month old twin boys, Christopher and Jonathan; Mr. and Mrs. Joe Polizzi, who are his parents by adoption; and many friends in Alberta and the Northwest Territories.

RCMP officer exonerated

OTTAWA (CP) — An RCMP officer has been exonerated in a court's instant trial of the shooting death of Chief Edd Bird in Yellowknife, N.W.T. Justice Minister John Turner said yesterday that the trial of Constable John Turner, 27, of the RCMP, and the hearing of the instant report were to be concluded Friday or Saturday.

He would read it before deciding whether to pursue the case. Justice General Jean D'Orville Goyer said he would read the report before deciding whether to proceed with an inquiry under the RCMP Act.

Chief Bird was shot to death several weeks ago by the RCMP constable.

THE OFFICER SHOULD BE CHARGED AND TRIED FOR MAN-SLAUGHTER OR MURDER AS WOULD HAPPEN TO AN INDIAN IF THE ROLES WERE REVERSED.

FOR YEARS THE NATIVE PEOPLE IN THE NORTHWEST TERRITORIES HAVE BEEN IN SECOND PLACE IN THE EYES OF THE GOVERNMENT. THE EXTRACTION OF RICH MATERIALS SUCH AS MINERALS, OIL AND NATURAL GAS HAVE COUNTED MORE THAN THE PEOPLE WHO LIVE ON THE LAND.

THE INDIAN BROTHERHOOD OF THE N.W.T. WANTS TO MAKE IT CLEAR THAT THE PRESENT GOVERNMENT POLICY FAVOURING RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT OVER THE NATIVE PEOPLE WHO FORM TWO THIRDS OF THE POPULATION IS NO GOOD. THE BROTHERHOOD AND THE NATIVE PEOPLE WILL FIGHT THIS POLICY IF IT CONTINUES.

RECENTLY THE BROTHERHOOD HAS TOLD BY A HIGH OFFICIAL IN THE MINISTRY OF INDIAN AFFAIRS AND NORTHERN DEVELOPMENT THAT POLICIES WOULD BE CHANGED TO RECOGNIZE THE NATIVE MAJORITY AND PUT ITS INTERESTS IN FIRST PLACE. SINCE THEN THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT HAS MADE ANOTHER ANNOUNCEMENT THAT IT HAS NOT CHANGED ITS POLICIES.

THE BROTHERHOOD INSISTS THAT THE GOVERNMENT RECOGNIZE THE DECISIONS OF THE LEADERS OF THE INDIAN PEOPLE AT THE ANNUAL CONFERENCE AT FORT RAE THIS JULY AND, AFTER DISCUSSIONS WITH THE LEADERS OF THE NATIVE PEOPLE, MAKE NEW POLICIES RECOGNIZING THAT THE IMPORTANCE OF THE HUMAN BEINGS IN THE NORTH TAKES PRIORITY OVER THE MINERAL WEALTH UNDER THE GROUND THAT THESE PEOPLE LIVE ON.

IT MUST BE KEPT IN MIND THAT TWO THIRDS OF THE PEOPLE IN THE N.W.T. ARE NATIVE PEOPLE; AND THAT WE HAVE SUFFERED AND WILL CONTINUE TO SUFFER IF WE ARE DENIED PRIORITY OVER RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT. WE WILL NOT BE IGNORED ANY LONGER WHILE THE GOVERNMENT AND CORPORATIONS TAKE ALL THE WEALTH FROM OUR LAND.

CONFINEMENT IN JAIL

AS WE ARE FULLY AWARE, EVERY COUNTRY IS EQUIPPED WITH INSTITUTIONS TO HOUSE THOSE WITH INDESECTIONS, SOME MINDS AND SOME GRAVER. MY EXPERIENCE IN THIS IS LIMITED TO THE "BIT TERM - MOST 97 DAYS.

AFTER THE USUALLY HARRROWING ORDEAL OF APPEARING BEFORE THE JUDGE YOU ARE TAKEN CARE OF SWIFTLY AND EFFICIENTLY...FOR THE CONVENIENCE OF THE AUTHORITIES, OF COURSE.

ALRIGHT, YOU ARE NOW CONFINED USUALLY IN A DAMP, DIMLY CELL WITH PROBABLY AN EX-DRUNK FOR A BABY-SITTER OR A NEUROTIC OLD PENSIONER, WHOSE BACK OR LEGS ARE TOO PAINFUL FOR HIM TO ACCOMODATE YOUR RIGHTS. IF YOU WANT TO USE THE PHONE, THIS IS YOUR PRIVILEGE, NOT YOUR RIGHT, AND YOU ASK THE POWERS TO BE. "WAIT A MINUTE, FELLOW," IS YOUR ANSWER.

THIS MINUTE OF COURSE RESULTS IN AT BEING AN HOUR OR MORE A DAY, ALL THIS TIME YOUR KEEPER IS BUSY SIPPING COFFEE OR BEING OCCUPIED WITH SOME OTHER UNNECESSARY ACTIVITY. FINALLY, THE KEEPER COMES.

"ALRIGHT WHO DO YOU WANT TO PHONE? MAKE IT QUICK, I HAVEN'T GOT ALL DAY." THIS IS SO DISTRACTING, YOU MOMENTARILY FORGET WHO YOU WANT TO CALL, YOUR WIFE, DOCTOR, LAWYER, OR WHO? IT DAWNS ON YOU ITS THE LAWYER. YOU FINALLY SET YOUR NUMBER AND THERE IS A PERSISTANT RING AT THE OTHER END. NATURALLY THIS IS AFTER HOURS AND HELPER IS AWAY TO THE COTTAGE AND CANNOT BE REACHED. "ALRIGHT BACK IN YOUR CELL!" YOU DEEM IT ADVISABLE TO BELIEVE THAT TOMORROW YOU'LL GET ANOTHER CHANCE. BUT "SUD'DY" YOU KNOW DAMNED WELL IT'LL END UP WITH SOME INCONSIDERATE RITUAL. THIS IS YOUR RIGHT, MAYBE YOU WANT AN APPEAL OR YOU WANT YOUR LAWYER TO QUESTION A TECHNICALITY. NEVERTHELESS YOU ARE JUST AS WELL TO CONCIDE TO DEFEAT. WHEN YOU GET TO THE JOINT IT LL BE A DIFFERENT MATTER, YOU THINK.

YES, THIS IS JUST PART OF IT, PRACTICALLY EVERY CONVICTED PERSON IS SUBJECTED TO THIS ORDEAL, ON THE OTHER HAND LETS TAKE A PEAK AT THE TROUBLES OF OUR OWN NATIVE. FROM HIS FIRST INTRODUCTION TO THE WORLD TO HIS EVENTUAL DIVORCE FROM SOCIETY.

IN THIS FAIR COUNTRY OF OURS - CANADA, A BEAUTIFUL, ABUNDANTLY RICH DOMAIN THERE LIVE MANY DIFFERENT TYPES OF PEOPLE THAT MAKE UP OUR SOCIETY - THE INDIAN OF COURSE BELONGS TO THE "MINORITY GROUP" - AND IT IS EXACTLY WHAT IT MEANS.

ORIGINALY THE WHITE MAN DECIDED THE INDIAN WAS A HEATHEN, ATHEIST PAGAN OR WHAT HAVE YOU. THIS ATTITUDE STILL PREVAILS, ANYWAY THE INDIAN WAS TO BE DETERMINED AN OUTCAST, AN UNWANTED AND UNNECESSARY BURDEN TO THE WHITE GOVERNMENT. IN ALL OUR TEACHINGS, PUBLICATIONS AND YES, EVEN COMIC BOOKS THE INDIAN WAS CLASSIFIED AS A LOWER FORM OF BEING, A SAVAGE, SOMETHING DETESTABLE TO THE EXTENT THAT EVEN THE INDIAN CHILDREN ARE ASHAMED OF THEIR NATURAL HERITAGE.

NOW, WHEN A NATIVE IS INCARCERATED, HAVING ALREADY HAD ONE STRIKE AGAINST HIM, HE'S IN A SORT OF A LIMBO - ACCEPTABLE WITH TOLERANCE FROM THE WHITE INSTITUTION, AND YET WANTS TO BELIEVE HE BELONGS. HE HAS AT HIS DISPOSAL MANY OPPORTUNITIES FOR BENEFITS THAT ARE DUE ANYONE, SO CONFINED, ACCESS TO THESE ARE ANOTHER THING. THE WHITE ADMINISTRATOR SHOULD, WELL KNOWING THAT A PERCENTAGE OF THE NATIVE INNATES ARE INFRONT OF THEIR RIGHTS, ASSIST THE POOR DEVILS IN THE PROCESS OF OBTAINING AND ENJOYING THESE BENEFITS. IT OCCURS TO THE WRITER THAT ONCE A PERSON HAS BEEN CONFINED, HE IS CONSIDERED ABSOLUTELY GUILTY AND MUST PAY THE CONSEQUENCES AS IF HE THE KEEPER ONLY WORK THERE FOR THE SOLE PURPOSE OF CONTAINING THIS PERSON, AND NOTHING ELSE. SOMONOF SHOULD ESTABLISH A REGIME AND A FORM SHOULD BE PREPARED NOTING STEPS IN SEQUENCE IN MAKING APPLICATION FOR WHATEVER THE NEEDS OF THE PERSON SHOULD BELIEVE. REQUEST FOR LEGAL AID, APPEAL ETC, FOR THESE FEW.

NOW, I SHALL RETRACE MY STEPS A BIT, YES, ORIGINALLY WE WERE SAVAGES (BUT NOT ATHISTS, PAGANS OR BARBARTANS) BUT WE WERE INTELLIGENT SAVAGES. THE WHITE MAN HAD ESTABLISHED HIS OWN INTELLIGENCE IN HIS OWN ENVIRONMENT AND THEY CENTURIES AGO BELIEVED IN THIS TRAIT INCLUDING ALL THE IDIOSYNCRASY THAT GO WITH IT. THE NATIVE ON THE OTHER HAD AN "ABORIGINAL" COMMON SENSE, IN THAT HE LEARNED TO LIVE WITH HIMSELF AS BEST HE COULD, HE SURFERED NO INNER TURMOIL AND DID NOT TAKE IT OUT ON ANYONE. AND TODAY YET HE IS CONSIDERS HIMSELF AT PAR WITH ANY HUMAN. THE AVERAGE WHITE MAN, DOESN'T REALLY APPRECIATE THE FULL IMPACT OF THIS UNFORTUNATE SOUL'S DILEMMA, WHEN THE INDIAN IS BORN, HIS ARRIVAL IS REPORTED TO THE INDIAN AFFAIRS - THIS DEPARTMENT AUTOMATICALLY ASSOCIATES HIM OR HER (POOR LIL DEVIL!) WITH A NUMBER 559. BANG! HE IS NOW A MEMBER OF THIS GREAT NORTH AMERICAN COUNTRY. THEN, SOME ONE CASUALLY ADVISES THE DEPARTMENT OF HIS NAME...WHO'S THE FATHER? WHO'S THE MOTHER? ARE THEY MARRIED? SHALL WE USE THE FATHER'S OR MOTHER'S NUMBER? THE LITTLE FELLOW GROWS UP A TRIFLE AND STARTS SCHOOL - DO YOU KNOW, THE LITTLE WHITE CHILDREN HAVE FOUND OUT HE HAS A FUNNY MONICKER - JOE STANDING - STRAIGHT UP, OR SOME OTHER, THE WHITE KIDS FIGURE THIS REALLY IS A FUNNY NAME.

AND THE POOR LITTLE BRAVELET GETS HIS PRIDE TUCKED IN BETWEEN HIS LEFS. HE IS VERY SUSPICIOUS OF THIS SOCIETY IMMEDIATELY. HE IS SELF CONSCIOUS OF HIS NAME, A NAME THAT THE INDIAN CULTURE ENTHUSIASTS SAY THAT HE SHOULD BE EXTREMELY PROUD OF. UNTIL.., THIS LITTLE INCIDENT IS NO HELL OF A BLOW TO HIS AND HIS PARENTS ORIGINALLY WELL MEANT HIPS - OF ACQUIRING A GOOD EDUCATION, IT ALSO SERVES TO CONTINUALLY DETER HIS SUBSEQUENT PROGRESS IN SCHOOL AND AFTER IN HIS FUTURE ROLE IN SOCIETY. THIS IS NOT TO BE CONSTRUED SOLELY A RESULT OF HIS NAME BEING KNOCKED HELL OUT OF, BUT ONE OF MANY, MANY LITTLE DRIDES FROM THE WHITES AGAINST THE INDIAN. AS WE ALL KNOW, THIS SUBJECT FINALLY LEAVES SCHOOL IN ALL PROBABILITY AS DROP OUT, USUALLY A DROP OUT IN ANY SOCIETY STANDS PRECARIOUSLY ON THE BRINK OF THE LAW AND EVENTUAL CONFINEMENT.

Riel diaries, letters to be published

MONTREAL (CP) — The man who wrote all publishing rights to Louis Riel's diaries says that emerges from the pages of the diaries as a "boldly idealistic, 19th-century invention of

In. B. G. Dobie, a Regina teacher, said the same Louis Riel diaries he has been in the charge of a boundary madman, writing himself up against the ridiculous notions of the man.

Dobie has entered into an agreement with the Saskatchewan government to have his diaries, memoirs, poems and letters published.

"It is time for the legend of Louis Riel to be laid to rest," said Dr. Dobie in an interview. "The man was a genius. He needed to relieve the tension and emotional heat 200 days of his life."

The diaries chronicle the upbringing, popularity, loves and losses of the man who died at Duck Lake and Remained to the end. They also show the prime days of Riel before he was brought to Regina for trial.

Dr. Dobie said the diaries are a special gift to the Canadian northwest and more particularly to the people of Saskatchewan.

Montreal. And at the same time these diaries are also the death warrant of the once proud Metis.

"Louis Riel, the tragic victim of the Red River Rebellion, the leader of the Metis, the founder of their province, and the leader of the Canadian west, was unable in 1885 to repeat his victory of 1869."

"The opening of the Canadian prairies, the completion of the railway and the virtual extinction of the buffalo herds all contributed to the decline of which the Metis had led on the Canadian plains for centuries."

"These diaries chronicle their hardships and realities as well as those of their chosen leaders."

Dr. Dobie said the diaries will be published in two volumes, one with about 1,000 pages and the other with about 800 pages.

"They will also show him as the man he was, a man of the great literary style of the 19th century."

"It may come as a surprise to discover in Louis Riel's diaries detailed discussions of a variety of topics such as politics, economics and of social and agricultural problems, as well as personal stories from those addressed by the leaders of the Third World countries."

Don't lose your pride, it's the only thing of value, that the white man hasn't bought yet. And don't let them put a price on your pride.

ALTOGETHER THERE WERE THIRTY BASKETS AUCTIONED OFF BY MR. BOB DESJARLAIS AT AN AVERAGE OF \$5.00 A PIECE, EXCEPTING THE ONE MADE BY MRS. BILL DESJARLAIS OF ABERNETHY WHICH WAS SOLD AT A PRICE OF \$15.25 TO MR. GORDON FAYANT, THE PRESIDENT OF THE BALCARRES METIS SOCIETY.

NO ONE HAD EVER SEEN SUCH AN OUTSTANDING BASKET AS THIS ONE AND HE WOULD LIKE TO CONGRATULATE MRS. DESJARLAIS FOR HER EXCELLENT WORK, AND ALSO THE OTHERS WHO MADE BASKETS.


