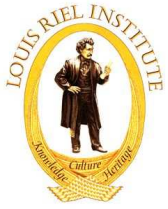


## **St. Norbert Parish Cart Trails** **Collected by Jim Jerome**

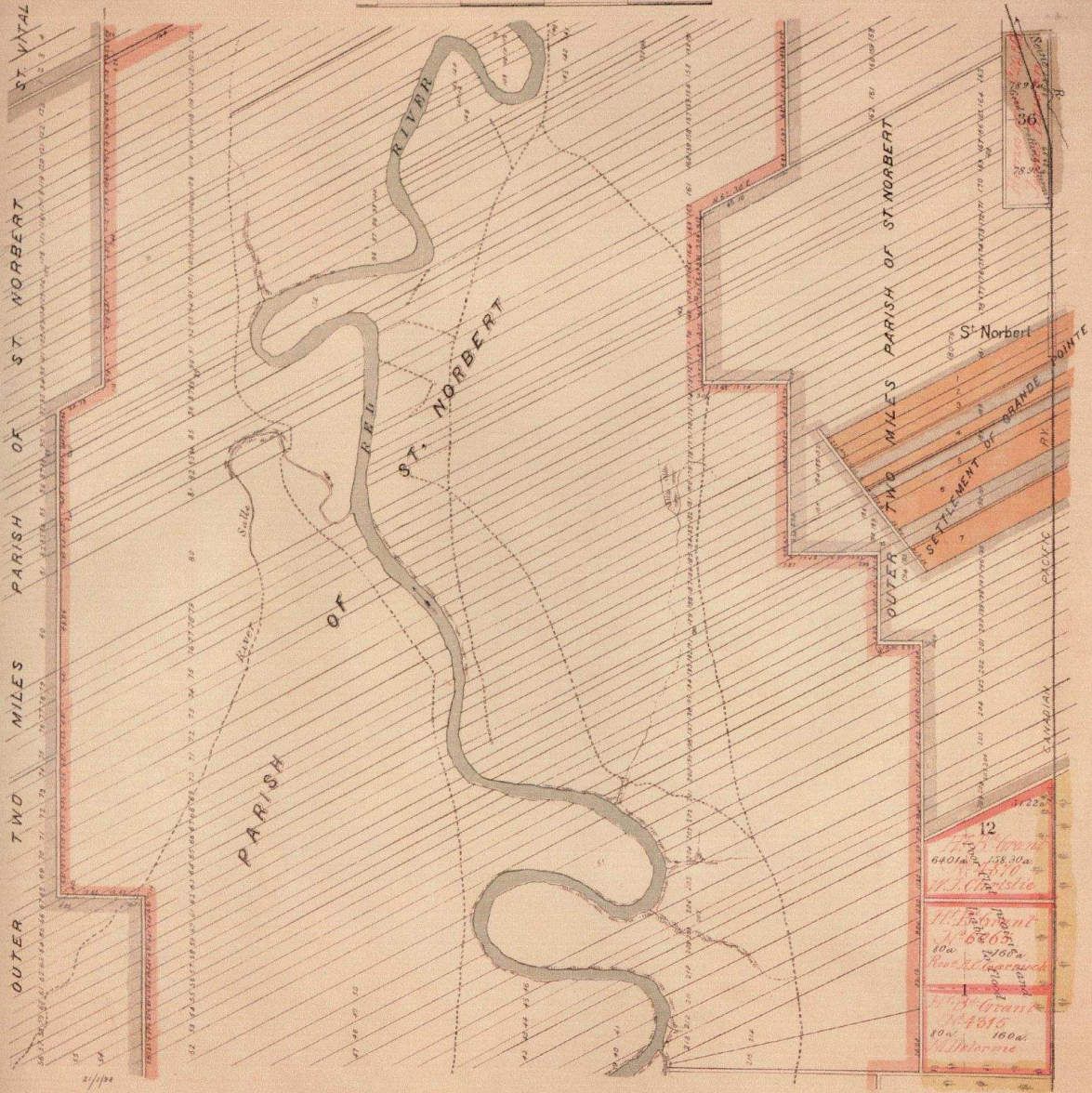
