## Foreword

The school dropout rate among Aboriginal students is estimated to be as high as ninety percent. For many, leaving school early is reflected in a future of unemployment, poverty and lost opportunities.

It gives us great pleasure to present to you a resource manual of individuals and organizations who are willing to speak, on a voluntary basis, on the topic of "Staying in School". These speakers offer a wide range of perspectives: some speak from the experience of having been dropouts themselves; some speak from an employer's perspective. Regardless of the perspective, all speak from the heart.

In the Fall of 1991, the Gabriel Dumont Institute received funding from Employment and Immigration Canada to set up Speakers Bureaus in Regina and Prince Albert. You will note, however, from the descriptions provided in this manual, that there are several speakers who would be willing to address audiences in other localities.

You may contact speakers for an engagement by using the phone numbers and addresses provided. We suggest that you talk to several speakers, prior to booking one (or more) for your speaking engagement.
