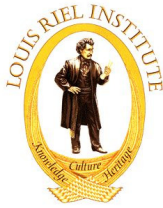


**Reverend John McKay.** (1832-1891)

John McKay was the son of James McKay and Margaret Gladu. He married Christina McBaeth, the daughter of Robert McBeath and Mary McLean in 1862 at Kildonan. They had eight children. He and his brother-in-law, Reverend James Nisbit were early settlers in Prince Albert in 1866. McKay represented the government at the signing of Treaty 5 at Berens River in 1875, and the signing of Treaty 6 in 1876 at Fort Carlton and Fort Pitt. His brother, the Honourable James McKay also played an important role in negotiating Treaty Six. He became a Presbyterian minister on Mistawasis Reserve.
