LESTOCK MEETING

March 26, 1982

Meeting opened by Area Director, Nap Lafontaine's comments on the Metis Farm.

Nap then introduced Arnold Tusa, P.C. representative from Cupar. He told the people present the P.C. Government policy is first decentralization of all people meaning ideas should come from down and up. He maintains that if his government get into power he will sit down with Native people and talk about the Metis Farm in Lebret. He is concerned about housing, education and job opportunties for Native people. He feels that welfare should not be used to get votes.

Ka pa chee Centre - Nap gave an outline of what Ka pa chee is all about explaining that it is not a building but rather a contractor to bring in credited programs to the Southeast Area and to the Locals. Mr. Tusa could not make a firm commitment as far as Ka pa Chee was concerned but again promised to talk and negotiate if his party gets into power after the elections.

Chris Lafontaine followed with a slide presentation to let the people the work that was down on the Lebret Metis Farm by the Southeast Area in order to get a proposal in to the Government of Saskatchewan.

Nap then updated on where the Farm is at the present time as to the decision that was made by the Government not to give the Farm over to the Treaty Indians on land entitlement. The Government decided to keep the farm but that it would be used as a training farm for people of Indian ancestry.

Frank Tompkins, Provincial AMNSIS Secretary then addressed the people present and gave his ideas concerning where we should go from here about the farm. He feels that the people should keep working to get the farm on the basis that at least part of it belongs to the Metis people due to the fact that it was the Metis people who laboured on this farm. It was paid for through sweat equity.

Nap. Lafontaine then asked the people for a mandate in order that he could go on working with the farm.

MOTION: Albert Bellerose moves that the Southeast Area continue fighting for the Lebret Metis Farm, not on the basis of aboriginal rights, but on the basis that the Metis People have "sweat equity" rights previously earned.

Seconded: Maurice Martin - All in Favor - Carried.
