Henry was born on Beardy's Reserve near Duck Lake, Saskatchewan. He is a well-known Métis fiddler and has won contests such as the Reg Bouvette Trophy at Batoche (1985-87). Traditional fiddlers such as Eli Dumont, John Champagne, and Alex Fayant were his early mentors. He currently lives in North Battleford, Saskatchewan.
