

Gariepy, Alexandre. (b. 1842)

Alexandre was born on May 11, 1842 at St. François Xavier, the son of Louis Gariepy and Josephte Ducharme. He married Genevieve Cadotte, the daughter of Joseph Cadotte and Genevieve Picard in 1864, and was later married to Mary Gaddy, the daughter of Alexandre Gaddy and Marguerite Kennedy in 1872. On September 7, 1876, he was one of 30 Métis at Fort Walsh who submitted a petition, on behalf of the Métis of the four districts of Assiniboia to join Treaty 4.
