

Slater, Jeremiah. (b. 1832)

Jeremiah and his brother Samuel both served as members of the 49th Rangers, the Métis Scouts of the British-Canadian Boundary Commission, 1872 to 1873.

Jeremiah was baptized on April 29, 1842 at St. John's, the son of John Slater (Scot) and Elizabeth Dennet (Métis), the daughter of William Dennet and Sophia Ballendine (Ballenden). Jeremiah and Mary Linklater had a child Margaret born May 24, 1862 but they never married,
