

Slater, Samuel. (1844-1904)

Samuel and his brother Jeremiah both served as members of the 49th Rangers, the Métis Scouts of the British-Canadian Boundary Commission, 1872 to 1873.

Samuel was born on March 11, 1844 at St. Paul's, the son of John Slater (Scot) and Elizabeth Dennett (Métis), the daughter of William Dennett and Sophia Ballendine (Ballenden). Samuel married Sophie Ann Knight, the daughter of James Knight and Elizabeth Haywood on January 11, 1877 at St. Paul's. Samuel died on September 24, 1904 and is buried at St. Andrew's Anglican Church.
